

Pre-Trial Intervention is a diversionary program in South Carolina designed for first-time offenders charged with non-violent offenses. It includes a prison tour, counseling, community service and programs specific to the criminal charge. Participants only have one shot at PTI anywhere in the state and must closely adhere to the program's requirements in order to be successful.

Upon successful completion, the charges against the participant will be dismissed and become eligible for expungement.

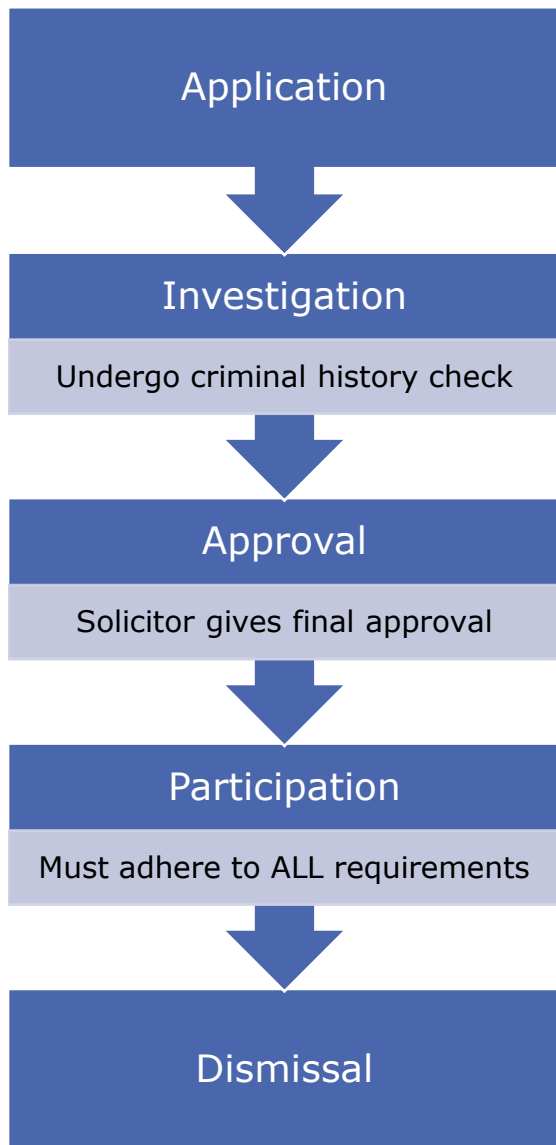
If the offender does not comply with the program's requirements, the case is subject to prosecution.

If the offender fails to comply with ALL program requirements, the case will be returned to court for prosecution.

Applying to Pre-Trial Intervention does not guarantee acceptance into the program.

Requirements

To be accepted into the program you must:

- Have a court referral.
- Complete the application. Incomplete applications *will not* be accepted.
- Make restitution, if applicable.
- Pay non-refundable \$100 (\$350 out-of-state) application fee.
- Pay \$250 participation fee.
- Attend and complete all assigned appointments, classes and programs.
- Submit random drug screenings
- Not engage in any criminal activity.
